Income Survey *Sunday 7th- Sunday 28th October*

If you are aged 16 or over, and St Andrews is your main church, and you have attended 12 times or more in the past 12 months, then you need to fill in an **Income Survey** form and put it in the box at back of Church by 28th October. This applies to us all as individuals and relates to our own personal income only (irrespective of any other income in your household) – even if you have little or no personal income you need to fill in the form. All forms are anonymous – no names or addresses – only a tick box for your income bracket. The information will help the Diocese make a fairer assessment of our Parish Share contribution (to pay for vicars' salaries, training, etc). Please ask us if you have any questions.
