Our parish share cost for 2019 is £32,000, which works out at roughly £2,667 per month out of our running costs. Coupled with £750 per month to pay for St Andrew's heat and light, each month our expenses (without any extras) are at least £3,500 which means the cost for each of us to worship together is over £10 per adult.
