Policy Statement on Children, Young People at the Church of St Andrew's

This statement was agreed at the PCC meeting held on: Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020

- 1. As members of this church, we commit ourselves to the nurturing, protection and Safekeeping of all, children and young people.
- 2. It is the responsibility of each one of us to prevent the physical, emotional, mental, sexual and spiritual abuse of children and young people and to report any abuse discovered or suspected.
- 3. We recognise that our work with children and young people is the responsibility of the whole Church.
- 4. Our church is committed to supporting, resourcing and training those who work with Children and young people and to providing supervision.
- 5. Our church is committed to following the policy and procedures published by the Diocese.
- 6. The parish will adopt good practice guidelines.
- 7. Each worker with children and young people must undertake diocesan Safeguarding training, know the guidelines and undertake to follow them. Each shall be given a copy of the Parish's agreed procedures and good practice guidelines.
- 8. Children and young people are an important part of our Church today.
- 9. We will listen to them
- 10. As we nurture them in worship, learning, and in community life, we will respect their Wishes and feelings.
