Celebrating the Gift of your Child

At St Andrew's we offer two different services in which we can celebrate the gift of your child.

Christenings (service of thanksgiving) The Christening Service is a wonderful way to thank God for the gift of your child as you make a decision on what is next for you in your journey of Faith. These are private services held after the main Sunday service at 12.30pm. In this service your child is blessed with their 'Christian' name and sponsors (equivalent of Godparents) are invited to support the child and parents in the years to come. There is no preparation required and services can be arranged by mutual agreement.

Holy Baptism (with water) are services held within the main Sunday service. As this is an official declaration of a commitment to starting a life-long journey of faith to ensure we can go ahead with a provisional baptism date we require families to attend at least 4 services over a two month period before the baptism and preparation sessions. We have our wonderful Sunday morning service at 10am 'All Ages at All Stages' or why not join us at our wonderful All Age Service each Thursday? Dates of baptisms are restricted to monthly scheduled dates.
